NARRATIVE OF VIOLATION: (EXPLAIN HOW THE FACTS WERE DISCOVERED/LEARNED AND WHO, WHAT, WHEN, WHERE AND HOW):

On September 29, 2016, I concluded an investigation regarding inmate Cartrette. The initial information obtained indicated inmate Cartrette was involved in forming an Anarchist Black Cross (an anarchist support organization) prison chapter in DRCI. On September 21, 2016, inmate Cartrette was placed in Special Housing on administrative hold pending an investigation. At the same time, a search of his property produced significant intelligence indicating that he was actively organizing, promoting and recruiting other inmates to form this prison chapter under the guise of "study groups". Confidential informant information has also been submitted which provides further detailed information regarding inmate Cartrette actions in promoting a prison work stoppage.

It was learned through this investigation that one of the primary purpose of these "study groups" was to build effective goal oriented, radical, small cell "study groups". The cells would be structured upon a simplified ideological foundation with a basic coherent organizational framework. Their primary goal is to organize, educate and politicize incarcerated inmates in Oregon to a sufficient enough extent that Oregon inmates will be able to take a more active role in a prison work stoppage movement.

Additional intelligence obtained included some outgoing letters written by inmate Cartrette in which he clearly states his intentions to create an ABC prison cell to orchestrate Oregon prison inmates to become involved in a massive prison work stoppage in all institutions.

The purpose of this prison work stoppage was to shut down the daily operations of the institutions based on the inmates' perception that institutions utilize inmate labor for capitalistic needs. Experience in a correctional setting has shown that inmates engaging in a planned prison work stoppage present a direct threat to the safety, security and orderly operations of the institution.
